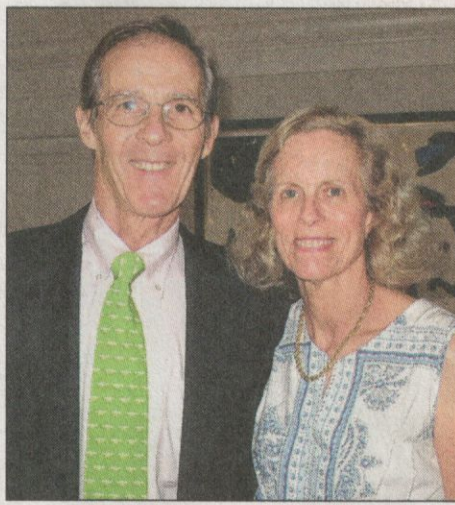
RECEPTION CELEBRATES ANTI-VIOLENCE INITIATIVE

Do The Write Thing ambassadors honored for efforts to combat violence.

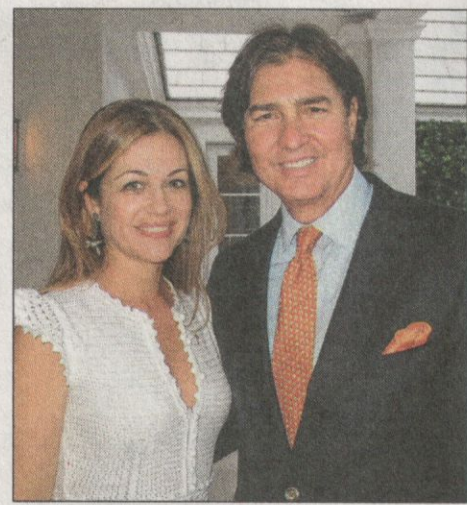
Lourdes and Pepe Fanjul Jr. opened their Palm Beach home for a reception celebrating the 2015 Do The Write Thing Challenge.
